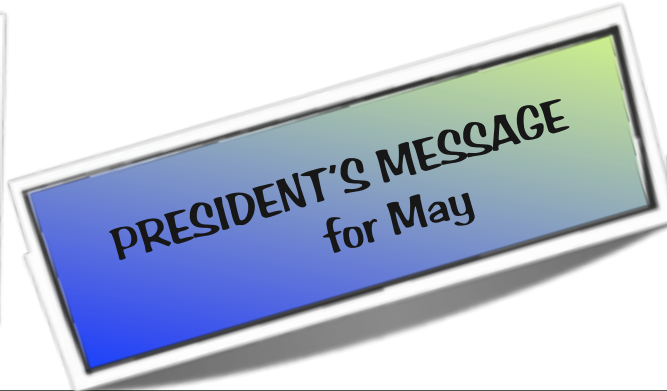
## The Traditions of Memorial Day

Many Americans observe Memorial Day by visiting cemeteries and memorials. A national moment of remembrance takes place at 3 p.m. local time. Another tradition is to fly the [flag of the United States](#) at [half-staff](#) from dawn until noon local time. One of the longest-standing traditions is the running of the [Indianapolis 500](#), an auto race which has been held in conjunction with Memorial Day since 1911. It runs on the Sunday preceding the Memorial Day holiday. The [Coca-Cola 600](#) stock car race has been held later the same day since 1961. [The National Memorial Day Concert](#) takes place on the west lawn of the [United States Capitol](#). The concert is broadcast on [PBS](#) and [NPR](#). Music is performed, and respect is paid to the men and women who died in war.
