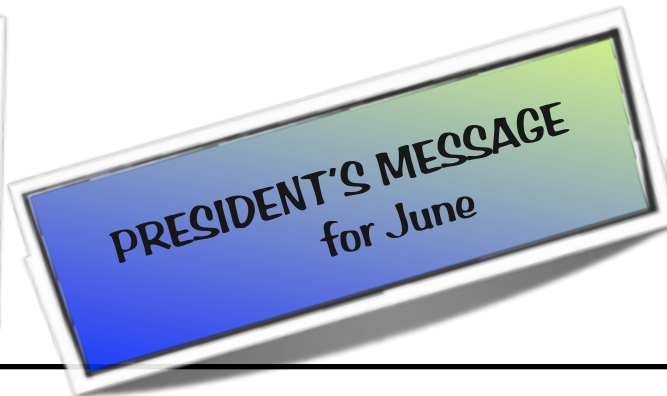
A Dad is a person

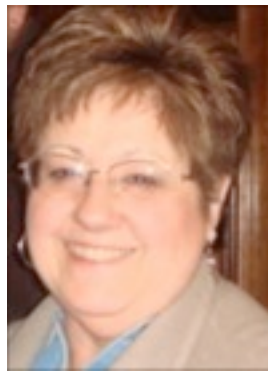
