WHAT IS THE HISTORY OF MOTHER'S DAY?

On this **day** in **1914**, **President** Woodrow Wilson issues a **presidential** proclamation that officially establishes the first national **Mother's Day** holiday to celebrate America's **mothers**.

Mothering Sunday is the fourth **Sunday** of Lent. Although it's often called Mothers' Day it has no connection with the American festival of that name. Traditionally, it was a day when children, mainly daughters, who had gone to work as domestic servants were given a day off to visit their mother and family.

Mothering Sunday. **Mothering Sunday** is a holiday celebrated by Catholic and Protestant Christians in some parts of Europe. It falls on the fourth **Sunday** in Lent, exactly three weeks before Easter **Day**. ... In the UK and Ireland, **Mothering Sunday** is celebrated in the **same** way as **Mother's Day** is celebrated elsewhere.

What flower is the symbol of Mother Day?

Perhaps the most traditional Mother's Day flower is the carnation. **Pink** carnations represent gratitude and love while **RED** carnations signify admiration. **White** carnations are traditional flowers to give or wear in remembrance of a mother who is no longer living.
